

P.R.O.U.D

Process for Gaining Approval to Raise a Seeing Eye Puppy

1. All applicants must have earned at least 24 credits and maintain a GPA of 2.50.
2. All applicants must have no outstanding discipline.
3. All applicants must apply as a group of two or more (a primary and at least one helper) and with a sponsor (a current P.R.O.U.D club member). All members must agree to all the rules and regulations of P.R.O.U.D., The University of Delaware, and The Seeing Eye.
4. All applicants must have permission from their parents/guardians.
5. All applicants must attend at least two meetings prior to applying.
6. All applicants must pass a certification quiz and receive at least a score of 70.
7. All applicants must fill out all applications and agreements and be approved. If living on campus, all applicants must apply for approved housing.
8. All applicants must complete a minimum of 50 hours of puppy exposure (earned by attending club meetings, events, and activities) and at least 1 overnight stay.
9. The primary applicant must call and speak to Seeing Eye Area coordinator Lisa Radcliffe.
10. After all applications and approvals have been met the applicants can be put on the list to receive a puppy.
